Upon investigation, I found that the wires hanging down were actually to a charging connector located in the rear of the car that I used to plug in my battery tender so no big deal. As I was investigating the plastic piece I had found and its potential location, that's when the real fun became obvious. The plastic piece is a cover for a major wiring harness connector that plugs into the ECM behind just to the rear of the front passenger side wheel inside the fender area. Not only is there one major connector; but three. All had been chewed on but only one had been removed and wires actually damaged. Just lovely. So after cleaning out the area, making sure no exposed wires were touching anything they should not, disconnecting the battery and repairing the charge connecter, I went to the web to source three new wiring harness connectors, covers and clamps. Not about to start the car until the damage is reviewed and repaired. I have visions of the engine or ECM just going boom. Ill be down for awhile. Stay tuned for the next installment.
