Meeting was called to order by our club president Lee Chadbourne promptly at 7:00 pm at Po'Boys Creole Café.

OLD BUSINESS: Lynda Watson presented the financial report. Bottom line is we are left with only \$107.00 after our current expenses were designated to be paid. This stirred up quite a lengthy discussion about having a bank reserve to pay for unexpected expenses. There was a proposal made by David Wiggins to maintain a minimum of \$500.00 in our bank account. That way in case of emergencies we are still covered. A final decision will be made at the next CCOT Board Meeting.

Linda Houck presented her projected expenses for our Christmas Party. The club has traditionally helped defray the cost of the Christmas Party, but given our current financial situation, after discussion, membership agreed to forgo the clubs \$400.00 supplemental support for the Christmas Party. A proposal was presented and membership agreed to increase the individual Christmas Party ticket cost to \$50.00 each.

The full cost for the flowers and NCM paver bricks for our 2 members who passed away this past summer have not been fully covered by donations. Lee will send out another e-mail to members requesting additional donations that will be dedicated to pay for the flowers and paver bricks. Lee will delay ordering the memorial bricks until we see what response the e-mail generates.

NEW BUSINESS: The trip to Charlotte, North Carolina; October 12-14, to see Rick Hendricks private collection of Corvettes has been coordinated and approved. The trip is an estimated 475 miles and estimated to take around 10 hours of travel time. Lee called a travel agency to get some package deals at the Charlotte Omni Hotel for double occupancy, Friday and Saturday night accommodations: 2 tickets to the NASCAR museum; transportation to/from the race; 2 race passes; all for around \$455.00 each.
