




Corvette Maintenance (Excerpts from Tender Rubbing Car -The Ultimate Detailing Newsletter) Detailing Wheel Wells

There is nothing worse than having a freshly detailed car and all that stands out is the unsightly wheel wells. You may be saying to yourself that they are behind the wheels, so who could see them. Easy! Just stand back and take a good look.


This is especially true if the vehicle has been lifted. They collect dirt, mud, and rust, and so this eyesore destroys the overall appearance of the splendidly shining, mirror-like vehicle; the good news is that this problem can easily be solved. With a little elbow grease you can have the wheel wells looking as great as the rest of the vehicle.


The front wheel wells contain steering assemblies, brake housings, and sometimes lift kits. This whole area can be painted flat or semigloss black. Black wheel wells look far better, compared to unsightly rusty ones. I like to use semigloss because it will be easier to clean in the future. I like seeing brake calipers painted, to match the car color (for example, painting a red car's caliper red creates a great look).



Some lifted trucks paint the various parts like the stabilizer bars, springs, and fittings to highlight the lift kit. If I'm selling the vehicle, I just paint everything black. This leaves a nice clean look--that is, unless it's an exotic, classic, or show car. In this case, paint each part the original color it received in the factory.


2007 Chicago Auto Show: Indy 500 Corvette Pace Car


BACK COVER

The Chevrolet Corvette will once again pace the Indianapolis 500 this year and, as usual, a limited number — 500 — of production versions will go on sale this spring. Available only as a convertible, the special edition comes in only one color, Atomic Orange, and comes with a number of dress-up items to grab the attention of otherwise colorblind passersby:

- Special Indianapolis 500 fender badges
- Z06 rear spoiler
- New aluminum "split-spoke" wheels in Sterling Silver
- Ebony seats with embroidered Indianapolis 500 logos
- Interior trim plate and pods painted Atomic Orange
- Atomic Orange engine covers

Otherwise, the pace car is a basic 2007 Corvette six-speed manual with the Z51 performance package, navigation system and Bose stereo. The price? It's \$66,995, including destination. A six-speed automatic with shift paddles is available and will cost \$68,245, including destination fee.







C1 - Optional engines in 1956 had nine fin alloy valve covers, 1957 had seven or nine fin alloy valve covers, and the 1958 had seven fin alloy covers on optional engines.


C2 - While the 427 was developed first, the 396 went into the Corvette, Chevrolet, and Chevelle in 1965 due to a GM policy restricting them to less than 400 cubic inches.

C3 - In 1969, the ignition lock was moved from the dash to the steering column. It would remain there until 1997 when it was returned to the dash.

C4 - In 1986, Corvette offered the "Malcolm Konner Commemorative Edition" with two transmissions. A manual 4speed and an automatic. Only 20 4-speed manual transmissions were installed at the factory.

A historic milestone was reached yesterday at St. Petersburg.



What seemed an embarrassment to some, Team Corvette racing unchallenged yesterday in its GT1 class (like Speed Channel's post-race insult to Vette heros Beretta & Gavin: "so guys, I guess the biggest challenge to you in this race was avoiding the road debris...") was in fact a much bigger triumph than winning that trophy.



Back in '96 GM hatched the plan to enter and race their number 1 crown jewel in the most grueling and prestigious road race in the world: the 24 hours of Le Mans. For those first few years starting in '99 Corvette Racing routinely got their asses kicked by the likes of Vipers (remember them?) and Ferraris (remember them, too?).

It goes without saying that there were people within GM ready to pull the plug on this "embarrassment" right then and there. But lead by Godug (& we mean *lead*) the team persevered, honed their skills, and stuck to three rules: Don't break it, Keep it on the track, and Take no prisoners. It all started to pay off in 2001 and in the following 6 years they've so far tallied up 5 class victories at Le Mans, 6 ALMS class victories, 5 driver championships, 4 Sebring class wins...


One by one, faced with this "GM Dream Team", the competition dropped out. All the menacing "racing giants" - Viper, Ferrari, Saleen, Lamborghini, Maserati, Porsche, and Aston Martin - just disappeared... Which brings us to yesterday. The milestone reached goes well beyond racing and right to the heart of what a company can do when they put their passion, people, technology, and commitment to a goal: They become second to none.


